Pre-existing practice experience, ideally with at least five years of specialized medical training/experience is also required.

Applicants should have established skills in Ophthalmology with extensive knowledge of physical assessment, differential diagnosis, pathophysiology, ocular pharmacology and management of acute and chronic eye conditions. A subspecialty interest would be an asset.

The ability to apply the principles, theories, practices, and techniques of optometric practice, including anatomy, physiology, pathology, and mechanics of the human eye, visual processes, and detailed knowledge of ocular pharmacology and therapeutics is desirable.
